

Premises Check List

You should address or consider all on this list

- Alarm System
 - Have it fully Monitored
 - Should know if disabled in anyway
 - At Least two forms of communication
 - Updated call list for them
 - When should police be called first?
 - Zero Alarm Delays on Glass Breakage and any doors you don't use to enter or leave when closing
 - That is once alarm is set, if compromised, alarm triggered instantly
 - Know what happens if tampered, lines cut or power outage
 - Alarm panel/control box in secure location
 - With motion sensors covering area
 - Have motion sensors above any drop ceiling
 - UL Certified systems guarantee a minimum standard of coverage
 - Alarm Sounders and strobes inside an out, as allowed by local code
 - Both sound and visible create instant awareness and attention
- Interior
 - Secure Doors that are not used when you enter or leave while open or closing
 - Bars or extra locking devices when closed
 - Follow any fire code issues while open
 - Consider using Burglar Resistant Glass on all exterior facing glass
 - Lighting is a great deterrent
 - Safes should be in a visible location
 - Burglars love out of sight safes, as they can work on them undetected
 - Avoid common walls with neighbors
 - Avoid external walls
 - Safes should have tamper sensors
 - No visible merchandise
 - Video Cameras covering store, safe area, and entries are critical today
 - Remote viewing capability a huge plus
 - I like to have a few "RING CAMS" in interior
 - Inexpensive & simple
 - Have audio in and out
 - Can sound an alarm
 - Set them to alert you if someone in your store after hours
 - faster than alarm company
 - Set Different alert sounds for inside store
 - At entry points as well as safe areas
 - Again, can alert you instantly, even before you get call from alarm company
 - Quick to remotely view if any issue or responding to alarm
- Exterior

- Lighting around entire store
- Be aware of any changes to any store connected to yours
 - Do they have alarms
 - Any construction
- Video cameras covering all sides of the store, and points of entry
 - Again, remote viewing capabilities are a huge plus
- Signage all side, any entry points, window areas
 - Store under 24 hour video surveillance
 - All valuable stored in vaults while closed
- I like to have a few “RING CAMS” on exterior
 - Inexpensive & simple
 - Have audio in and out
 - Can sound an alarm
 - Set them to alert you if someone loitering around areas
 - Set Different alert sounds for outside store
 - Quick to remotely view if any issue or responding to alarm
- Law Enforcement
 - Make sure you have great relationship with them
 - Have understanding of what each party expects from each other
 - Have a few basic principles covered?
 - Have system for a basic walk through when open if you have a suspicious situation in the store
 - How will hold up alarms be responded to
 - How will late night alarms be responded to
 - I prefer alarm company contact them if burglar alarm activated for faster response
 - Glass breakage
 - door activation
 - Interior motion
 - But Not for supervisory or communication errors
 - Can they contact you 24/7
